

## SCOUTMASTER'S SPECIAL RULES: BOY SCOUT CAMP

- I have read, understand, agree with and have signed The Troop 61 Code of Conduct. I understand that, as well as those rules; there are special rules we will follow at Scout Camp. The most important is the Golden Rule: To treat other people as I want them to treat me. As well:
- I will act as a proud member of Troop 61, understanding that all of my deeds and actions reflect not only on myself but my fellow Scouts and leaders.
- I will attend all classes and programs and do my best to complete my assignments and badges.
- I will pitch in on Troop projects and, when it's my turn, jobs such as KP or lolly detail.
- I will look after my fellow Scouts, offering them support, help and-most important-friendship.
- I will not "pull rank" to gain privilege or opportunity. I will not "punish" other Scouts by assigning extra KP, lolly detail or other campsite tasks. That's the job for the Scoutmaster.
- I will respect the camp program and property, and will follow all camp rules.
- If I am going to leave the campsite during free time, I will tell the Camp Scoutmaster or another adult leader where I'm going. If I'm taking a hike, I will bring at least two other boys with me.
- When called Braves and called Warriors are on silence (including on Call Night) I will leave them alone. I will not bother them; talk to them or in any way attempt to force them to break silence. I understand how serious it is to disregard this rule.
- I will not prank, harass, tease or in anyway bother any Scout or group of Scouts, staff member or adult...or any of their property. I understand how serious it is to disregard this rule.
- I will remember a Scout is clean. I will not use inappropriate language or actions. I will keep my tent, equipment and campsite clean. I will take showers, brush my teeth and change my clothes daily.
- If I am an adult, I will remember the Camp Scoutmaster runs the Troop and the campsite. Unless a matter of life or limb, I will defer all decisions and actions... to the Camp Scoutmaster. I also will follow BSA's role for Two Deep leadership at all times.
- I will remember how much my family loves me, and thank them in my special way for caring enough to give me this opportunity.
- I will have a wonderful time, filled with fun, memories and excitement!
- I acknowledge an infraction of any of these rules will lead to actions by the Troop and/or BSA camp leadership, which could include being sent home from camp or removal from Scouting.
